



**Mount Galiano**  
 Mt Galiano Nature Protection area is the island's highest point of land (314m) and comprises 81 hectares. It was purchased in 1991, after an energetic and creative fundraising campaign by the island community.



**Bluffs Park**  
 The Bluffs Nature Protection area, named for the magnificent 300ft shoreline 'bluffs' located above Active Pass, comprises approximately 139 hectares (342 acres) of green space. The Bluffs is also the site of the historic Japanese Charcoal Pit Kiln created in the early 1900s.

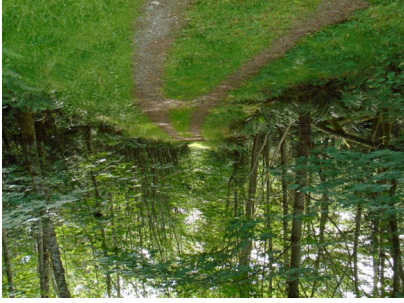
Hints and Registration Information inside....

The first 100 completed passports will receive a commemorative coin designed by Two young local artists, Simon Doty-Housden and Keirah Kerr.

Collect at least four (of the 6) stamps and mail your completed passport to: The Galiano Club, 141 Sturdies Bay Rd., Galiano Island, BC, V0N 1P0.

This passport contain the coordinates for each cache, and a spot for the designated stamp. (There will be a different stamp in each geocache.) Find the cache, stamp your passport, then re-hide the cache carefully.

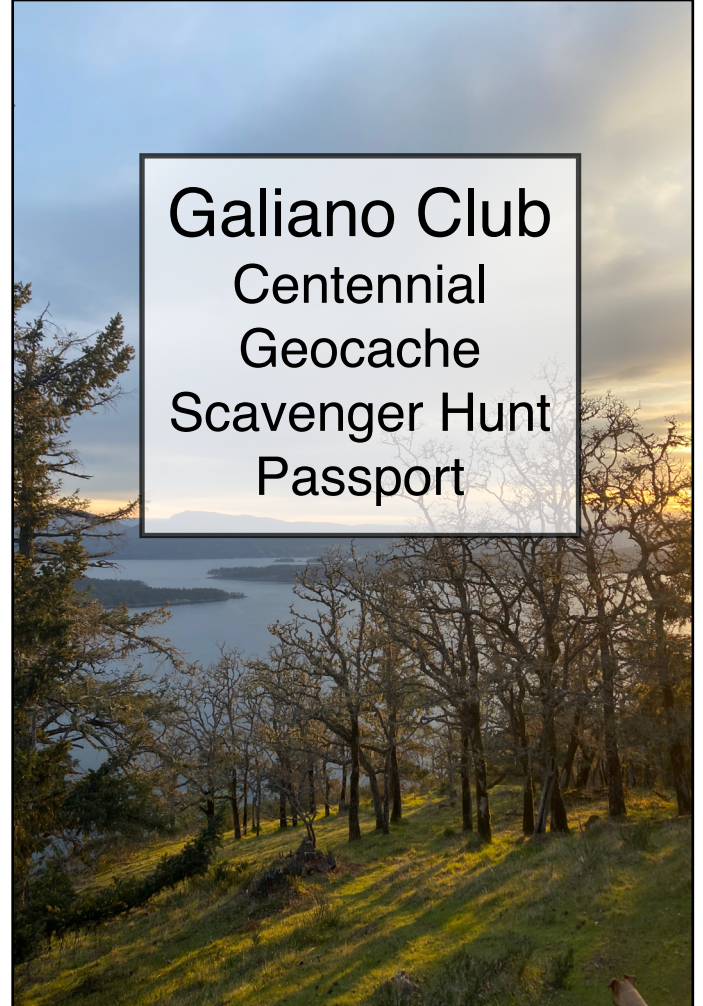
**The Community Forest**  
 The Community Forest — zoned as Heritage Forest — located at the end of Georgia View Road, is 126 ha of land owned and managed by the Galiano Club. The area contains an extensive network of hiking trails

# Galiano Club Centennial Geocache Scavenger Hunt Passport

## How to Find the Geocaches

There are several ways to see the locations of each geocache:

- Scan the QR code using a mobile phone camera.
- Enter the coordinates provided for Google or Apple maps on a mobile phone map app.
- Enter the coordinates provided for GPS into a handheld GPS device.

### Deer Cache

(Google or Apple Maps) 48.906567, -123.389933  
(GPS) N 48° 54.394' W 123° 23.396'



**Hint:** Relax and enjoy the view from the top of wildfire loop. Then take 9 steps backward to a small stand of 4 willow. And look down.

### Salmon Cache

(Google or Apple Maps) 48.910333, -123.390183  
(GPS) N 48° 54.620' W 123° 23.411'



**Hints:** Just NW of the Arbutus trail head - look for Margarets commemorative Dogwood, and the cracked rock at your feet.

### Webbed Arbutus Crevasse Cache

(Google or Apple Maps) 48.867860, -123.3395500  
(GPS) N 48° 52.043' W 123° 20.224'



**Hints:** Look for an Arbutus Crook on top of the Bluffs

### Under a Stone Resting Spot Cache

(Google or Apple Maps) 48.869333, -123.343472  
(GPS) N 48° 52.16' W 123° 20.608'



**Hints:** The kiln is directly in front of you when sitting on this hard, but maybe decent seat.

### Double-Eyed Dragon Cache

(Google or Apple Maps) 48.863806, -123.363361  
(GPS) N 48° 51.83' W 123° 21.80'



**Hints:** If logs could see, these might be eyes. (You'll need to reach in.)

### Three Trail Fork Cache

(Google or Apple Maps) 48.869833, -123.359194  
(GPS) N 48° 52.19' W 123° 21.552'



**Hints:** Stay Calm and look for a sign where three paths converge.

### Registration:
